## i3: history and features

- started from scratch in february 2009
- successor\* to wmii, which we couldn't hack
- clean, readable, documented code. and documentation
- proper multi-monitor support, utf-8 clean
- fast and lightweight, aimed at power users

### Inter-process communication

- UNIX socket, JSON for serialization
- i3-msg (C), AnyEvent::13 (Perl), i3-ipc (Ruby), i3ipc (Python)
- send any command, like floating enable
- receive events (like focus change)
- access the layout tree (!)

## Example workflows

- Urgency hint
- Scratchpad
- Web development (browser, editor, syslog)
- Coding (C): two editors (code, test), quickly opening docs

## i3 in numbers

- 3149 commits by 39 different people
- > 600 tickets (about 60 open)
- about 10.000 SLOC (mostly C, a bit of Perl)
- testsuite: > 1000 test instructions in 96 files
- conservative guess of > 1000 users
